- Submit one letter of recommendation from a teacher, mentor, or community leader
- Official Academic Transcript
- Write a 500 word essay (typed and double spaced) on the following topic:

Explain the importance of having an education. How will you use that knowledge to grow as a person today, and improve society for the future?

- For those interested in a career in the healthcare field, an additional \$1,000 Healthcare Scholarship is available. Write a 500 word essay (typed and double spaced) on the following topic:

Why are you interested in the health care field? Describe a significant interest or experience that has had a major impact on your health care career goals.
